



We need to talk about E-waste

E-waste is a fast growing problem for our planet

E-waste or electronic waste is created when an electronic product is discarded after the end of its useful life. The rapid expansion of technology and the consumption driven society results in the creation of a large amount of e-waste

E-waste is considered the fasted growing waste steam in the world with 44.7 million tonnes generated in 2016, equivalent of 4500 Eiffel towers. In 2018 an estimated 50 million tonnes of e-waste was reported, thus the name tsunami of e-waste given by the UN.

The harmful effects of e-waste on the environment are caused by poisonous toxins within the electrical equipment itself. E-waste is far from biodegradable meaning that any tech abandoned to landfill will remain there indefinitely releasing toxins into the environment via groundwater, soil and air therefore in land and sea animals. These toxins can also have a detrimental affect on human life causing health issues such as kidney, lung and central nervous system damage.

Repairing a broken device is not always economically viable. With the cost of new parts being so expensive often it is more viable to purchase a new device. Consumers are opting to buy new, and we understand this logic.
